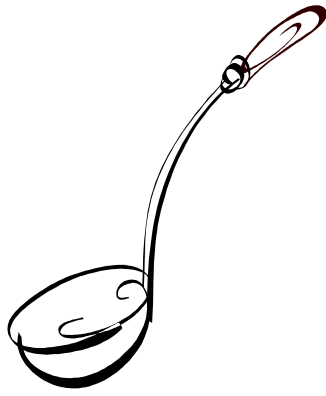

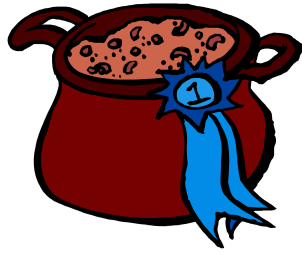

Cooking Equipment:

- Sturdy camp table or other cooking surface
- Benches, folding chairs or camp stools
- Butane, propane or similar camp stove (not to exceed 1 gal size container)
- Cooking pot, sturdy stirring spoon, ladle
- Cutting board(s), knives, water, cooler (for meat & refreshments for team members)
- Hot pads

Booth Space Provided

- 10x10 space (INSIDE THE MALL)
- Mall will provide 1 8-foot table for serving.
- Booths will be located throughout the entire mall common areas. Spaces will be assigned on a first-come-first-served basis.
- Decoration (props, costumes, etc) encouraged and will be judged on theme, costumes, overall appearance, audience appeal.
- Music can be playing if it's a part of your theme

BOOTH THEME/DECOR

- Individuals and teams may compete.
- Chief Cook is responsible for the conduct of his team members.
- At least one team member must hold a current County Food Handler's Permit and must oversee team conduct with regards to sanitation.
- Chili may contain any combination of meats, chili peppers, spices and other ingredients such as beans.
- No ingredient may be precooked in any way prior to the official starting time. Exceptions canned or bottled tomatoes, sauces, peppers, pepper sauces beverages, broths or herbs.
- All chili must be prepared and cooked onsite
- Meat may be precut and seasoned, but not precooked
- Marinated meats are allowed
- All other ingredients must be chopped or prepared at the cook-off but not prior to the cook-off starting time.
- Minimum cooking time shall be 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours. Maximum is 3 hours.
